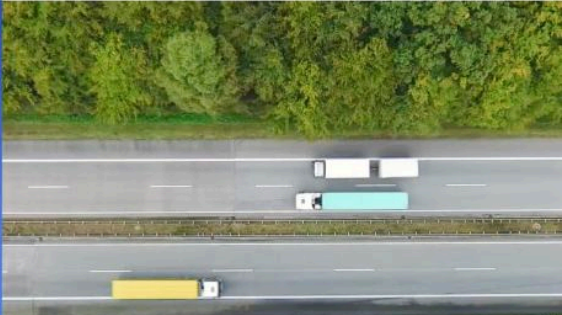

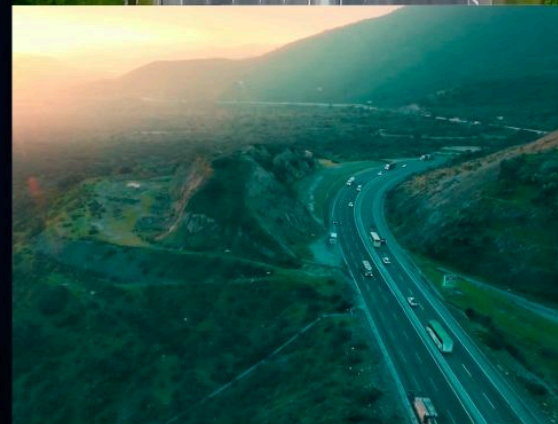




Company profile

The challenge

Abertis' main challenge was to **manage the contract lifecycle efficiently and consistently within a complex corporate environment**

characterised by a high contract volume, multiple stakeholders (internal and external), and demanding requirements in terms of control, traceability, security, and regulatory compliance.

More specifically, the multinational company faced the following challenges:



Integrations with corporate platforms.



Driving cultural adoption to consolidate a more structured and digital operating model.



Reviewing and updating existing contract templates to facilitate automation.
